

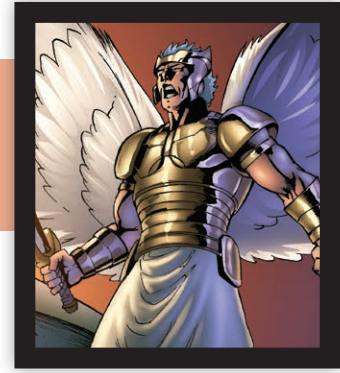

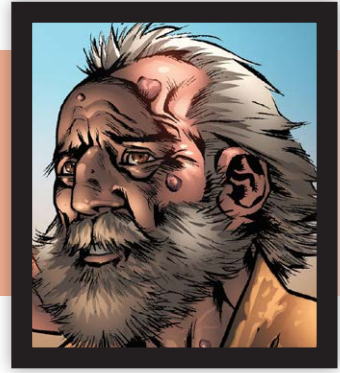

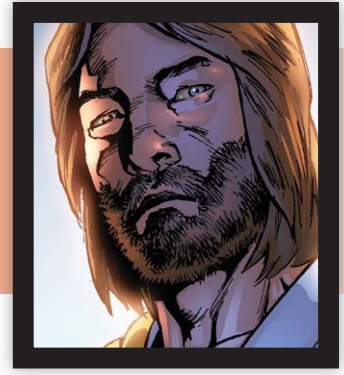

What words of Jesus most stood out to you?

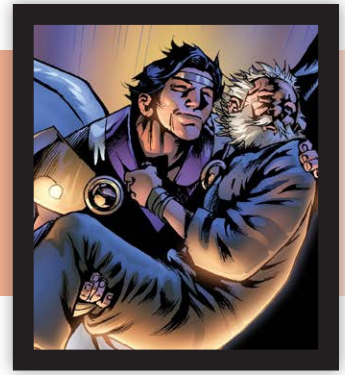
Why were the Pharisees so upset with Jesus?

What do you think it might be like when you arrive in Heaven? What do you hope it is like?

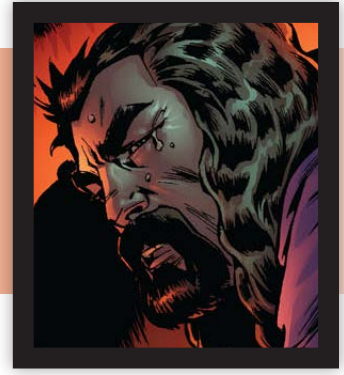
Why does Lazarus say he's rich when he gets to paradise (page 61) though he hasn't received any possessions?

How is Phineas's attitude when he's in hell different from how it was while on earth? How is it the same?

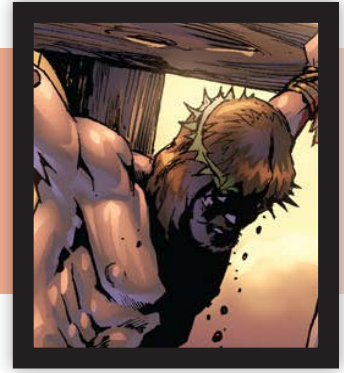
What do you think Abraham meant when he said to Phineas "You did not choose to know." How can we minister to people who have heard the gospel and rejected it?

How does the concept of eternity affect how you live today?

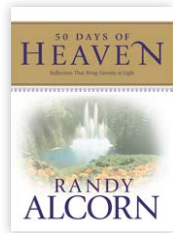
On earth it looked like Phineas was blessed and favored by God, but now we see it was Lazarus. What does this show you about what God values and what the world values?
